About IIC Institute: The University was founded on August 26, 1975 under Uttar Pradesh University Act no.10 – 1986 section 4, sub-section 1-A vide notification no.10/15-60-33/74. It is the only premier institute of higher learning and research catering to the academic needs of 7 districts of Bundelkhand region, most of which are underdeveloped and backward. Despite trifling or almost no financial support from the state government, the University has set standards at par with those of various other private and international education centers in the country.

Bundelkhand University is the Number One University of Uttar Pradesh and has been accredited twice by the NAAC. It has more than hundred courses at UG, PG and Doctorate Level encompassing all the major fields of studies e.g. Basic and Life Sciences, Engineering and Technology, Pharmacy, Physiotherapy, Agriculture, Management, Food Science & Technology, Tourism and Hotel Management, Earth Sciences, Library & Information Science, Law, Computer Applications, Education, Arts and Fine Art, Environmental Studies, Forensic Science and Criminology, Languages and other Social Studies. The University established its IIC on 19th August 2021, and since then, till August 2022 has conducted various IIC/Self Driven and Celebration Activities other than attending all MIC activities. (list attached).

The IIC Bundelkhand University achieved a 2 star rating in IIC 3.0, eventhough the work had been done for only eleven days. For the Qtr I and Qtr II of IIC 4.0 the IIC at the Bundelkhand University has achieved 2/2 rating and 50/50 points

The University has various facilities and bodies which will facilitate Pre Incubation, Incubation and Entrepreneurship in the University

- a. **Innovation Center:** The University has a state of the Art Innovation Center. Innovation Centre, Bundelkhand University, Jhansi provides analytical facilities in the area of biological, physical and chemicals sciences. The centre has established Central Instrumentation Facility (CIF) to promote R&D in university and its affiliated colleges and to provide analytical facilities to researchers and industries throughout India. Sophisticated analytical instruments are vital for pursuing research and performing quality R& D. X Ray Diffractometer, Gas Chromatograph Mass Spectrometer, Ultra Centrifuge, Digital Imaging System, Multi Mode Microplate Reader, Real Time PCR, PQMS, Two Dimensional Gel Electrophoresisa etc. These instruments are expensive and cannot be provided through individual project mechanism. Moreover, these instruments are of inter/multidisciplinary utility and thus it is desirable to use them on sharing basis for their optimum utilization.
- b. **Entrepreneurship Development Cell** is being constituted in the University with a dedicated team of actively working faculty who has an industry exposure along with some student representatives. Aspiring entrepreneurs shall be groomed with the necessary inputs on how to be a successful entrepreneur through workshops and seminars by eminent people from the industry. The BUEDC shall encourage the students to consider self-employment as a career option by providing necessary training in Entrepreneurship skills through standardized courses. The cell shall also organize different activities and events from time to time to train and motivate the students on entrepreneurship. The BUEDC shall strive to bridge the gap between Industry and Academia. The cell shall undertake several activities for student development to provide them corporate exposure while studying and develop a spirit of entrepreneurship.
- c. Internal Quality Assurance Cell In pursuance of the National Action Plan of the National Assessment and Accreditation Council (NAAC), Bangalore, for performance evaluation, assessment and accreditation and quality upgradation of institutions of higher education, the NAAC proposes that every accredited institution should establish an Internal Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC) as a postaccreditation quality sustenance measure. Since quality enhancement is a continuous process, the IQAC will become a part of an institution's system and work towards realising the goals of quality enhancement and sustenance. The prime task of the IQAC is to develop a system for conscious, consistent and catalytic improvement in the performance of institutions. The IQAC will make a significant and meaningful contribution in the post accreditation phase of institutions. 





There the students were technically told that the 10 acre solar plant is a 2.5 mega-vote plant, in which electricity is generated from the rays of the sun through the solar plate, which through the SMB box sends DC current to the transformer and AC power. This is a significant reduction in the electricity bill from the solar plant, BHEL's Deputy Manager KD Gupta told the students that the entire solar plate is connected to a software. So that the working capacity of each plate can be seen on the computer screen and it is also known that how much electricity is generated by the solar plant in a day.

CHIEF GUEST, PROF. MANOJ DIXIT in his key note address that it is a credit facility originally envisioned by the Government of India in the National Education Policy (NEP) 2020. The scheme has the provisions of creating a digital infrastructure that will store the academic credits earned by the students of various higher education institutes within the country. He added that the ABC will be entrusted with the responsibilities such as opening, closing, and verifying the individual academic accounts of students. It'll also be responsible to gather the academic credits earned by the students from their respective higher education institutions, verify the credits, store the credits, transfer or redeem such credits, and promote them as and when required among its stakeholders. He explained that the bank will start functioning with over 290 top Indian higher education institutions participating in the academic session 2021-2022. Among these will have all institutes that are in the list of top 100 of the National Institutional Ranking Framework (NIRF) and also all those institutes which are accredited "Grade A" by the National Assessment and Accreditation Council (NAAC) Speaking about the Features, and Functions of Academic Bank of Credit, he informed the participants that the scheme will include all kinds of courses offered by the Higher Education Institutes and which are recognized by the University Grants Commission (UGC), be it a graduation course, postgraduate course, PhD courses, diploma courses, certificate courses, etc.It covers courses offered through any medium, be it regular classroom courses or open/distance learning courses or online courses. SWAYAM, NPTEL, V-Lab and such other schemes offering their courses are also eligible to avail the facilities provided by Academic Bank of Credit. In general the credits earned by students will carry a validity of 7 years unless otherwise specified for that particular course; and upon the end of the validity period these credits will expire. The ABC will not accept any kind of credit course document by the students but rather only from the higher education institution he/she is enrolled in. These institutes will be responsible to deposit these credits into the student's ABC account regularly. He finished with the remark that it is wonderful initiative by UGC-HRDC, JNVU, Jodhpur and BUNDELKHAND UNIVERSITY to organize this webinar on NEP 2020 awareness.

CHAIRPERSON of the webinar Prof. Mukesh Pandey in his keynote address discuss about the Significance of Academic Bank of Credit. He said that the credits stored in the individual accounts of the students will give them a much larger scope of freedom in terms of their academic/career choices. The students will be able to drop out of their institute from any year/semester and exchange the credits earned so far with a certificate/diploma if eligible. They will also be able to redeem the credits and rejoin the same institute or some other institute of his/her choice at the same time or some other time in future and continue from the year/semester his education is pending from. He added that it will not let the time a student has spent for his higher education go waste if he/she decides to drop off the course/institute for any reason. The scheme will do away with the coercive system adopted by some institutes to keep the student enrolled in their courses against their will, with the motive of earning money. In the end of his address, Prof. Mukesh Pandey conveys his thanks to the UGC-HRDC, JNVU, and Jodhpur to collaborate with Bundelkhand University for conducting the webinar. He added that such collaboration will certainly extend to other activities in near future

The NATIONAL WEBINAR on NEP: 2020 MULTIDISCIPLINARY EDUCATION AND RESEARCH

He invited Prof. Sunil Kumar Kabia, Dean Student Welfare and Director of IQAC in Bundelkhand University, Jhansi for welcome address. Vranda Dubey, student of BIMCJ, BU, Jhansi read the citation of the chief guest of the webinar PROF. VINAY KUMAR PATHAK, Vice Chancellor, Chhatrapati Sahu Ji Maharaj University, Kanpur, CHIEF GUEST, PROF. VINAY KUMAR PATHAK in his key note address that New Education Policy 2020 will emerge as a game changer in the education scenario in India. India which is well known for a long tradition of holistic and multidisciplinary learning in the 'liberal arts', from universities, such as Takshashila and Nalanda to the extensive literatures of India combining subjects across fields. Ancient Indian literary works like Banabhatta's Kadambari described a good education as knowledge of the 64 Kalas or arts; and among these 64 'arts' were included subjects such as singing and painting, but also more 'scientific' fields, such as chemistry and mathematics, more 'vocational' fields, such as carpentry and clothes-making, more 'professional' fields, such as medicine and engineering, as well as 'soft skills', such as communication, discussion, and debate. He added that Assessments of educational approaches in undergraduate education that integrate the humanities and arts with STEM have consistently showed positive learning outcomes, including increased creativity and innovation, critical thinking and higher-order thinking capacities, problemsolving abilities, teamwork, communication skills, more in-depth learning and mastery of curricula across fields, increases in social and moral awareness etc, besides general engagement and enjoyment of learning. He also informed about a comprehensive holistic arts education that will develop all capacities of human beings - intellectual, aesthetic, social, physical, emotional, and moral - in an integrated manner. A holistic arts education will help develop well-rounded individuals that possess: critical 21st century capacities in fields across the arts, humanities, languages, sciences, social sciences, and professional, technical, and vocational fields; an ethic of social engagement; soft skills, such as communication, discussion and debate; and rigorous specialization in a chosen field or fields. He said that even engineering schools, such as the IITs, will move towards more holistic education with more arts and humanities, while arts and humanities students will aim to learn more science - while all will make an effort to learn more vocational subjects. India's rich legacy in the arts as well as in the sciences and beyond will significantly help in making the move towards a holistic arts education an easy and natural transition. He finished with the remark that it is wonderful initiative by UGC-HRDC, JNVU, Jodhpur and BUNDELKHAND UNIVERSITY to organize this webinar on NEP 2020 awareness. He said that imaginative and flexible curricular structures will enable creative combinations of disciplines for study and would offer multiple entry and exit points, thus removing currently prevalent rigid boundaries and creating new possibilities for life-long learning. Graduate-level (master's and doctoral) education in large multidisciplinary universities, while providing rigorous research-based specialization, would also provide opportunities for multidisciplinary work, including in academia, government and industry. He share with the participants that Model public universities for holistic education, at par with IITs, IIMs, etc., called MERUs (Multidisciplinary Education and Research Universities) will be set up and will aim to reach the global status of, e.g., the Ivy League Universities in the U.S. They will help set the highest standards for holistic education across India. In the end of his address, Prof. Mukesh Pandey conveys his thanks to the UGC-HRDC, JNVU, and Jodhpur to collaborate with Bundelkhand University for conducting the webinar. He added that such collaboration will certainly extend to other activities in near future. Later on in the Question Answer session experts answers some queries of the participants. Prof. Rajesh Kumar Dubey, Director, UGC-HRDC, JNVU, Jodhpur ask the participants to fill up the feedback form to be provided on social media groups formed for the webinar. Dr. Nidhi Sandal, Assistant Director, UGC-HRDC, JNVU, Jodhpur informed the participants about the coming activities of the UGC-HRDC, JNVU, Jodhpur. Prof Shiv Kumar, Head, Institute of Food Technology discussed about new developments in the field of food packaging and new concepts coming up. Sri Amit Pandey, CEO and Director of Safal Food Processors, Jhansi talked about new food products developed by his industry and packaging requirements for the development of new products. Dr Tanweer Alam, Director Indian Institute of Packaging told about status of packaging Industry in India and International scenario. He talked about 3P, 5P and 7P concept in the food packaging industry. Packaging is responsible for the increasing shelf life of food products. Once the food is packaged with suitable and ideal packaging material the product life increases. The products which are packed in suitable, attractively designed packages are easy to market. The packaging material must be well designed and utilization of the material must be to its fullest. There are different packaging requirements like rigid, semi rigid and flexible packages which must be used as per requirement. The customized packaging is very important these days. The primary, secondary and tertiary packaging has to be decided as per the compatibility of the product. More than 65 % of plastic is used by food industry. More than 500 million persons are involved in the field of packaging in the world.


