


- a. Support undergraduate/ postgraduate and Research Scholars of partner institutions as Co – Guides.

- f. Organizing training programs and faculty development programs for teachers. Need based training programs for faculty members may be designed, organized and conducted by both Parties.
- g. Creation and promotion of joint credit and non credit based MOOC programs.
- h. Submit collaborative research projects for funding to national and international agencies on relevant subjects, themes or topics on mutually agreed terms and conditions
